## **STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL**

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF GRANT AGREEMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY

Public Resources Code section 40000 *et seq.* authorizes the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the State, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and,

In furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, award, and management of the grants; and,

CalRecycle's grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by Resolution specific authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and,

The City of Stockton authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for the Tire Rubberized Grant Program, for which the City of Stockton is eligible; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to submit a grant agreement to CalRecycle for Fiscal Year 2022-23 funding.

2. The City Council hereby authorizes the submittal of grant-related documents to CalRecycle for all grants for which the City of Stockton is eligible.

3. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to execute all necessary grant-related documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary for the purpose of securing grant funds and implementing the approved grant project.

4. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to make all necessary appropriations and undertake any other financial actions that may be necessary to accept, receive, and spend the grant funding.

5. These authorizations are effective for a period of five years from the adoption date of this Resolution.

6. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
