


## Planning Commission Action

City staff will provide an oral report on the actions, communications, and outcome of the Planning Commission Hearing on the Project scheduled for September 21, 2023.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Approve a Resolution certifying the Environmental Impact Report, including a Statement of Overriding Considerations, Findings of Fact, Mitigation and Monitoring Reporting Program, and Errata to the Final Environmental Impact Report; and
- Approve a Resolution approving a Master Development Plan, with Conditions of Approval, and a Development Agreement; and
