RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE30-22, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE INSTALL LEFT-TURN SIGNALS AT THREE INTERSECTIONS, PROJECT NO. WT19001/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. HSIPL-5008(183)

On October 13, 2022, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Install Left-Turn Signals at Three Intersections, Project No. WT19001/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(183); and

The project will install protected left-turn lanes and update signal heads at the intersections of March Lane and McGaw Street, El Dorado Street and Robinhood Drive, and El Dorado Street and Benjamin Holt Drive. This signal phasing modification will improve safety by reducing right-angled collisions at the three intersections; and

Dirt Dynasty, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$764,000, and its bid is regular and responsible in all respects; and

Caltrans National Environmental Policy Act determination was received on November 12, 2019. The State determined that the project is a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3). Similarly, the project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code section 65402; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE30-22 under CEQA for the Install Left-Turn Signals at Three Intersections, Project No. WT19001/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(183), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Install Left-Turn Signals at Three Intersections, Project No. WT19001/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(183).

3. The City Council approves the appropriation of additional Highway Safety Improvement Program funds in the amount of \$184,860 to the Install Left-Turn Signals at Three Intersections, Project No. WT19001/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(183).

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Dirt Dynasty, Inc., in the amount of \$764,000, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
