RESOLUTION TO CREATE NEW CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATIONS OF PAYROLL ANALYST I/II/SENIOR, DEBT AND TREASURY MANAGER, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED SALARY RANGES

It is necessary to establish a new classification of Payroll Analyst I/II/Senior to perform a wide range of highly responsible, confidential, and complex financial duties with set procedures in the maintenance and processing of the City's payroll function and amend the salary range for the existing Payroll Supervisor classification; and necessary to establish a new classification of Debt and Treasury Manager responsible for debt structuring, cash forecasting, investments, and compliance with legal and disclosure requirements; and necessary to establish a new classification of Assistant Director of Public Works to support the Director of Public Works in administering the programs and activities of the department and providing expert professional assistance to city management staff on public works matters; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The new unclassified/unrepresented class specifications of Payroll Analyst I/II/Senior, Debt and Treasury Manager, and Assistant Director of Public Works are hereby created with the salary ranges approved as follows:
