## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CORONAVIRUS SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUNDING, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$972,181, FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 20, 2020, THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2022, AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 ANNUAL BUDGET

In May 2020, the Stockton Police Department (SPD) submitted an application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA); and

The Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program, which will provide funds to assist eligible states, local units of government, and tribes in preventing, preparing for, and responding to the coronavirus; and

As a recipient of Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funds since 1997, which helps local government combat crime and improve public safety, the SPD was eligible to apply and submitted an application for CESF Program funds based on a formula allocation of \$972,181; and

The SPD's comprehensive plan to effectively manage the coronavirus pandemic identifies the necessary resources to effectively support its sworn and non-sworn staff; and

In June 2020, the SPD received notification from BJA awarding funds in FY 2019-20 in the amount of \$972,181; and

A Grant Award Document is attached as Exhibit 1. Grant funds will be used to pay overtime, equipment, hiring, supplies, and training/travel expenses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept the grant award in the amount of \$972,181 for the period January 20, 2020, through January 31, 2022, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant application.

2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Grant Award Documents, attached as Exhibit 1, and all related documents necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of the grant award and this Resolution.

3. The Fiscal Year 2019-20 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$972,181 in revenues and expenditures for the Police Grants and Special Programs accounts as needed to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
