Ordinance No. 011-05 C.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE STOCKTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 3-106.1, LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE TO CHAPTER 3, ADMINISTRATIVE, PART IX, BIDDING, CONTRACTING, AND PURCHASING PROCEDURES, DIVISION 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF CODE.

Chapter 3 of the Stockton Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding Section 3-106.1, Local Business Preference which reads as follows:

Part IX BIDDING, CONTRACTING AND PURCHASING PROCEDURES

Division 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

SEC. 3-106.1. LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE:

Preference shall be given to the purchase of supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services from local merchants, quality and price being equal. Local merchants who have a physical business location within the boundaries of San Joaquin County, and who have applied for and paid a business license tax and registration fee pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code Chapter 6, Division 5, shall be granted a three (3) percent bid preference. The two (2) three (3) percent preference shall be based on the amount of that portion of the bid which is subject to sales tax. This is intended to provide preference in the award of certain City contracts in order to encourage businesses to move into the City.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

In the event any section or portion of this Section shall be determined invalid or unconstitutional, such section or portion shall be deemed severable and all other sections or portions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
