RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR EQUITABLE COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION GRANT PROGRAM

The State Department of Toxic Substances Control has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of the Equitable Community Revitalization Grant Program; and

The City of Stockton is an eligible applicant under the Equitable Community Revitalization Grant Program; and

The Program aligns with ongoing efforts to assess and cleanup Brownfields sites in Downtown Stockton; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Hereby approves the filing of an application through the Equitable Community Revitalization Grant Program.
2. Delegates the authority to the City Manager, or designee, to accept the grant award, conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests.
3. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.
4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
