APPROVE A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE 2014 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT, PHASE 1 (PROJECT NO. M14006), AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT, AND APPROVE THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE001-16 UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

On April 7, 2016, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton (City) opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project, Phase 1 (Project No. M14006); and

Mozingo Construction, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$572,885; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to Mozingo Construction, Inc., the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$572,885, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, by Section 15301, Class 1 and Section 15302, Class 2 of the CEQA Guidelines because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE001-16 under CEQA for this project, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council adopts the plans and specifications for the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project, Phase 1 (Project No. M14006).
3. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Mozingo Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$572,885, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
4. The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to execute all documents, including, but limited to, agreements, and amendments.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
