RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A STATE OF CALIFORNIA ADAPTATION PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM AWARD TO UPDATE THE CITY OF STOCKTON CLIMATE ACTION PLAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$650,000

The City Manager authorized staff to apply for a Round 1 Adaptation Planning Grant Program (APGP) in the amount of \$650,000; and

On June 8, 2023, the Governor's Office of Planning and Research, awarded the City of Stockton a \$650,000 Round 1 Implementation Grant for Stockton Climate Action Plan; and

The APGP Grant Round 1 will provide funding needed to update the City of Stockton's Climate Action Plan (CAP) which was initially developed in 2008 and implemented from 2014-2020; and

A new Climate Action & Adaptation Plan will provide the City of Stockton with a plan to adapt previously implemented strategies and expand activities that will aide in the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and improved local economic, environmental, and health outcomes throughout the City of Stockton; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorize the City Manager to execute a grant agreement in the amount of \$650,000 with the California Governor's Office of Planning and Research (OPR).
2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$650,000.
3. Authorize the City Manager to execute and manage sub-agreements with co-applicants in amounts consistent with the Grant Agreement.
