AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STOCKTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 3, CHAPTER 3.68 – BIDDING, CONTRACTING AND PURCHASING, ARTICLE I – GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 3.68.090 – LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: AMENDMENT OF CODE

Stockton Municipal Code Chapter 3.68, Article I, Section 3.68.090 – Local Business Preference is hereby amended to read as follows:

TITLE 3 REVENUE AND FINANCE

CHAPTER 3.68 BIDDING, CONTRACTING AND PURCHASING PROCEDURES

ARTICLE I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

SEC. 3.68.090 LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE

Preference shall be given to the purchase of supplies, materials, equipment, and contractual services from local merchants, quality and price being equal.

Local merchants who have a physical business location within the boundaries of San Joaquin County, and who have applied for and paid a business license tax and registration fee pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code <u>Title 5</u>, Chapter 5.08, <u>License Taxes</u>, shall be granted <u>a three (3)two (2)</u> percent bid preference.

Local merchants who have a physical business location within the boundaries of the City of Stockton, and who have applied for and paid a business license tax and registration fee pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code Title 5, Chapter 5.08, License Taxes, shall be granted five (5) percent bid preference.

The three (3) <u>applicable</u> percent preference shall be based on the amount of that portion of the bids which is subject to sales tax. This <u>section</u> is intended to provide preference in the award of certain City contracts in order to encourage businesses to move into and expand within the City.

SECTION II: SEVERABILITY

In the event any section or portion of this <u>Section_ordinance_shall</u> be determined invalid or unconstitutional or <u>any portion shall</u> be deemed severable <u>and,</u> all other <u>remaining_sections</u> or portions thereof shall remain in full force and effect.
