This Amendment Number 5 to the above referenced Agreement is entered into on _____ between the City of Stockton ("City") and Hard Luck Animal Welfare Advocate "Contractor".

RECITALS

Exhibit C General Terms and Conditions, Paragraph 7 Changes, states the City may modify the scope of services and any material extension or change in the scope shall be memorialized in a written amendment prior to the performance of additional work; and

Exhibit C General Terms and Conditions, Paragraph 8 Amendment, states no variation of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless an Amendment is made in writing and signed by both parties; and

Exhibit A, Option to Renew, states both Parties may extend this Agreement up to two (2) one-year extension, by a written amendment executed by both parties extending the term by one (1) year at a time; however, the total term of the Agreement including the extended term shall not exceed five (5) years; and

The City needs to renew the term specified in Paragraph 2 of the Standard Agreement for veterinary services and support of the animal shelter.

The City needs to amend Exhibit A, Section 3.1, to add four (4) additional contractor personnel to work on-site at the community veterinary clinic.

1.The termination date in Paragraph 2 of the Standard Agreement is amended to: June 30, 2027

2.The maximum not to exceed amount to be paid to the Contractor, including if authorized, reimbursement of expenses, in Paragraph 3 of the Standard Agreement and Exhibit E, Section 1.1, will now read as follows:

1.1 "The maximum the Contractor shall be paid on this Agreement is \$3,969,675 (hereafter the "not to exceed" amount). The "not to exceed" amount includes City approved reimbursable expenses, if any, and all payments to be made pursuant to this Agreement's sum for the initial term and extended term. Nothing in this Agreement requires the City to pay for work that does not meet the Standard of Performance identified in Exhibit D section 4 or other requirements of this Agreement.

Initial Term the maximum not to exceed amount is \$6,794,344.38

Extended Term the maximum not to exceed amount is \$3,969,675

Total maximum compensation to be paid to the Contractor under this Agreement for the initial term and the extended term shall not exceed \$10,764,019.38

3. Four (4) additional Contractor personnel positions will be added to the original contract scope.


All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and remain in full force and effect unless modified by a written amendment signed by both parties.
