RESOLUTION APPOINTING FIVE NEW COMMITTEE MEMBERS TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The Community Development Committee is a seven-member advisory committee that provides the Council with recommendations on the planning and use of funds that the City receives from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, including Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnerships Program, and Emergency Solutions Grant funds; and

As provided for in the Council-adopted Citizen's Participation Plan, appointments to the Community Development Committee are made by the Mayor and each Councilmember which are then ratified by the City Council; and

Appointments are for four years, except when an appointee is filling the remaining term of a vacant position; and

Currently, five vacancies exist on the Community Development Committee; and

The City placed a notice in The Record soliciting applications for the vacancies and the recruitment process resulted in the submittal of 16 applications which were forwarded to the Mayor and appropriate Councilmembers for consideration and selection; and

Five of the applicants were selected for appointment subject to Council ratification; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Melvin Boles is hereby appointed to a term representing District 1 on the Community Development Committee beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2019.

2. Michael Marino is hereby appointed to a term representing District 5 on the Community Development Committee beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2019.

3. Randy Burns is hereby appointed to a term as the At-Large representative on the Community Development Committee beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2017. This term has been shortened to align with the Mayor's term of office.

4. Sally Wooden is hereby appointed to a term representing District 2 on the Community Development Committee beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2017. This term has been shortened to align with the appointing Councilmember's term of office.

5. Michael Blower is hereby appointed to a term representing District 4 on the Community Development Committee beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2017. This term has been shortened to align with the appointing Councilmember's term of office.
