STOCKTON PLANNING COMMISSION

RESOLUTION FORWARDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT A GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT TO MODIFY EXISTING AND INCORPORATE NEW GOALS, POLICIES, AND IMPLEMENTATION MEASURES RELATED TO 200-YEAR FLOOD RISK AND PROTECTION

California Government Code section 65302.9 requires that each city and county within the Sacramento-San Joaquin Valley amend its general plan within 24 months of July 2, 2013, to include information specific to flood risk and goals, policies, and implementation measures for the protection of lives and property from a 200-year flood event; and

The Stockton General Plan 2035 Goals & Policies Report, adopted on December 11, 2007, contains 11 elements, each of which identify goals, policies, and implementation measures to guide future land use, development, and environmental protection decisions; and

The Health and Safety Element of Stockton General Plan 2035, Section 11, subsection 11.6 - Flood Hazards identifies goals, policies, and implementation measures related to flood hazards; and

In order to comply with California Government Code section 65302.9, and based on guidance provided in the California Department of Water Resources' document entitled <u>Guidance on General Plan Amendments for Addressing Flood Risk</u>, dated September 2014, staff reviewed Stockton General Plan 2035 and determined that an amendment is necessary; and

Staff now recommends that the Planning Commission forward a recommendation to the City Council to adopt a General Plan Amendment to modify existing and incorporate new goals, policies, and implementation measures related to 200-year flood risk and protection in compliance with California Government Code section 65302.9; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Planning Commission hereby forwards a recommendation to the City Council to adopt a General Plan Amendment as set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
