RESOLUTION APPROVING NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE03-23 TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION OFFICE OF GRANTS AND LOCAL SERVICES FUNDING FOR CITY OF STOCKTON AQUATIC AND PARK FACILITIES PROJECT

The City of Stockton Aquatic and Park Facilities project includes improvements at Victory Park, McKinley Park, and Fong Park; and

The Victory Park Pool Replacement project includes replacement of the pool, pool house, and increasing the pool size to accommodate four swim lanes; and

The McKinley Park Renovation project includes the pool, pool house renovations, and park amenities. The park renovations and improvements include: new picnic shelters, new ball fields, new play area, new restroom, basketball courts, futsal courts, soccer fields, new trees, landscaping and irrigation system modification, path lighting, one parking lot modification, parking lot resurfacing, low impact development improvements to the parking lot, swimming pool, and bath house renovations; and

The Fong Park Improvements project includes completion of the park, installation of new trees, walkways, lighting, grass areas, and irrigation systems; and

The State grant program requires the projects obtain California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) clearance approval before submitting grant applications to the California Department of Parks and Recreation Office of Grants and Local Services. The projects are in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and are categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA as specified under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE03-23 under CEQA for the City of Stockton Aquatic and Park Facilities project for improvements at Victory Park, McKinley Park, and Fong Park, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
