STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 FEE SCHEDULE RELATED TO STREET AND SIDEWALK VENDORS

In 2018 and 2022, the State Legislature passed separate bills addressing street and sidewalk vendors and their activities throughout the State. Senate Bill 946 (2018) and Senate Bill 972 (2022) regulate allowable enforcement measures for both General Law and Charter Cities; and

In an attempt to bring the Stockton Municipal Code ("SMC") into compliance with State law, Stockton Police Department Neighborhood Services Section ("NSS") reviewed current SMC provisions related to street and sidewalk vendors and found several areas for potential improvement; and

NSS has proposed several amendments to the current SMC to bring City enforcement of street and sidewalk vendors into compliance with State law; and

The City seeks to implement fines consistent with State Law to curb street and sidewalk vending conducted in violation of the proposed amendments to the SMC and to amend the Public Works fee schedule for the recovery of costs for work created by the activities of vendors and their clients in public parks as allowed by the provisions of State Law; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the amendment of the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Fee Schedule to create new fees concerning street and sidewalk vendors attached as Exhibits 1 and 2 and incorporated by this reference.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
