West Yost Associates is found to be the most qualified proponent; and

City staff negotiated a fee of \$1,099,224 for the professional service agreement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the following findings pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code section 3.68.070 in support of an exception to the competitive bidding process:
 - a. Use of the RFP process is appropriate for this Professional Services Agreement because it relies on the evaluation of professional qualifications and performance as the basis for selection of a vendor. Use of the criteria helps ensure selection of a vendor that will provide the highest quality professional service, which is in the public interest.
 - b. The City negotiated an agreement following solicitation of competitive proposals in accordance with SMC section 3.68.070.A.3.
- 2. The City Council awards a Professional Services Agreement between the City of Stockton and West Yost Associates, in the amount of \$1,099,224, for the Wastewater Master Plan Update (Project No. M20024), and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute the same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
