RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO SCHRADER MECHANICAL, INC., AND APPROVING THE FILING OF A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE014-16 FOR THE OUTFALL CONTROLS IMPROVEMENTS – PROJECT NO. M14010

On July 14, 2016, the City received three bids for the Outfall Controls Improvements Project No. M14010. The project is for the improvement of the system controls of the Outfall at the City's Regional Wastewater Control Facility; and

Schrader Mechanical, Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$259,638.12; and

The bid submitted by Schrader Mechanical, Inc. is regular and responsive in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is exempt from the requirements of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section(s) 15301, Class 1 and 15302, Class 2(P16-0301), of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Outfall Controls Improvements - Projects No. M14010.
2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Schrader Mechanical, Inc. in the amount of \$259,638.12 for the Outfall Controls Improvements - Project No. M14010, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file the Notice of Exemption No. CE014-16 under the CEQA for this project, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.
4. The City Council approves the appropriation of \$259,638.12 from the Capital Improvement Program, Account No. 437-7709-670 (Municipal Wastewater Utility – Capital Improvement Program Wastewater – RWCF Modifications and Replacements).
5. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute all documents, including, but not limited to, agreements and amendments.

6. The City Manager is authorized to take such other actions as are appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
