## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO A.M. STEPHENS CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. FOR THE FREMONT SQUARE SIDEWALK RECONSTRUCTION PATH (PROJECT NO. PW1438/ATPL-5008(140))

On May 18, 2017, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Fremont Square Sidewalk Reconstruction Path (Project No. PW1438/ATPL-5008(140)); and

The Fremont Square Sidewalk Reconstruction Path project is located within Fremont Square Park bounded by San Joaquin, Sutter, Lindsay, and Fremont Streets in Stockton. The project will reconstruct the perimeter sidewalks, remove and replace curb ramps, relocate pedestrian lighting, add bicycle racks, remove/trim trees, and restore irrigation/turf; and

On January 13, 2015, by Resolution No. 2015-01-13-1201, Council accepted and appropriated \$728,000 of Active Transportation Program State grant funds for the Fremont Square Sidewalk Reconstruction Path project and authorized the filing of a Notice of Exemption under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

A.M. Stephens Construction Co., Inc. is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$480,971.20; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to A.M. Stephens Construction Co., Inc., the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$480,971.20, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Fremont Square Sidewalk Reconstruction Path (Project No. PW1438/ATPL-5008(140)).
- 2. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and A.M. Stephens Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$480,971.20, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

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3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
