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RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED FOR COGENERATION ENGINE NO. 1 PROJECT NO. M09102, APPROVING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. MUD-CE-5-15, APPROVING THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS AND ADDENDA, AND AWARDED A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO COLLICUTT ENERGY SERVICES, INC. FOR THE COGENERATION ENGINES NO. 1 AND NO. 4 OVERHAUL AND SOURCE TEST PROJECT NO. M16009

On August 14, 2014, bids were received for the Cogeneration Engine No. 1 Overhaul and Source Test, Project No. M09102; and

Before award of the project for Cogeneration Engine No. 1, a failure occurred to Cogeneration Engine No. 3 requiring analysis and review resulting in the decision to postpone award of the project for Cogeneration Engine No. 1; and

An investigation into the failure of Cogeneration Engine No. 3 has been completed; and

During the investigation of Cogeneration Engine No. 3, Cogeneration Engine No. 4 reached the recommended run-time limit; and

The Municipal Utilities Department subsequently determined that both Cogeneration Engines Nos. 1 and 4 would need to be overhauled; and

On October 15, 2015, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed bids offered for the Cogeneration Engines No. 1 and No. 4 Overhaul and Source Test Project (Project No. M16009); and

Collicutt Energy Services, Inc. (Collicutt) is the apparent low bidder in the amount of \$1,087,922; and

The bid submitted by Collicutt is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. All bids for the Cogeneration Engine No. 1 Overhaul and Source Test (Project No. M09102) received on August 14, 2014, are hereby rejected.

2. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. MUD-CE-5-15 under the CEQA for the Cogeneration Engines No. 1 and No. 4 Overhaul and Source Test (Project No. M16009), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council approves the project specifications and addenda for the Cogeneration Engines No. 1 and No. 4 Overhaul and Source Test (Project No. M16009).

4. The City Council, authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Collicutt of West Sacramento in the amount of \$1,087,922 for the Cogeneration Engines No. 1 and No. 4 Overhaul and Source Test (Project No. M16009), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed execute all documents, including, but not limited to, agreements and amendments.

6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
