RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$126,997 FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CLEAN CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY CLEANUP AND EMPLOYMENT PATHWAY GRANT PROGRAM

The City of Stockton ("City") is interested in promoting youth workforce development programs, particularly those that endeavor to empower youth; and

The State of California has made funding available under the Clean California Program to support litter abatement and public space beautification efforts on locally owned public right-of-way while creating workforce development opportunities for youth facing barriers to employment; and

The State of California awarded the City of Stockton a \$126,997 Community Cleanup and Employment Pathway grant to build upon the success of the Youth Employment Summer Success program by engaging middle school youth in environmental education, civic pride, and hands-on community service; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorize the City Manager to execute grant agreement with California Department of Transportation in the amount of \$126,997 (Exhibit 1).
2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant revenues and expenditures for the Community Cleanup and Employment Pathway grant program in the amount of \$126,997.
3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
