# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS, NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE24-25, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE MORMON SLOUGH IMPROVEMENTS, PROJECT NO. WD25034**

On May 8, 2025, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Mormon Slough Improvements, Project No. WD25034; and

The project will remove, replace, and/or install sidewalks, curbs, and gutters, and Americans with Disabilities Act compliant curb ramps located near Spanos Elementary School. Improvements will also be made along Sutter Street between Hazelton Avenue and the railroad tracks, and along Aurora Street between Hazelton Avenue and Scotts Avenue; and

FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$427,569; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$50,000 from the Sidewalk, Curb, and Gutter Repairs Program Fiscal Year 2023-24 SB1, Project No. WD24004, to the Mormon Slough Improvements, Project No. WD25034.

2. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE24-25 under the CEQA for the Mormon Slough Improvements, Project No. WD25034, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Mormon Slough Improvements, Project No. WD25034.

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$427,569, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

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5. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
