RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$51,125 FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE SEXUAL ASSAULT LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIALIZED UNIT PROGRAM GRANT; APPROPRIATING A TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT CASH MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,042; APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 ANNUAL BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT DOCUMENTS

The City of Stockton (City) desires to continue participation in the Sexual Assault Law Enforcement Specialized Units grant program to be funded in part from grant funds administered by the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES); and

Following the City's interest for additional available funding, Cal OES awarded an additional \$51,125 for the grant program for the period of July 1, 2016, through September 30, 2017; and

The Sexual Assault Law Enforcement Specialized Units grant program requires a twenty-five percent (25%) local match. The match amount is allocated in the General Fund Grant Match account budget and an appropriation in the amount of \$17,042 is required; and

The Stockton Police Department, as the lead agency for the Sexual Assault Law Enforcement Specialized Units program, investigates sexual assault crimes, and collaborates with the Women's Center Youth & Family of San Joaquin County to provide services and support to sexual assault victims; and

The Grant Award Agreement details how grant funds will be used to pay for various personnel resources, training, and miscellaneous materials and supplies; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The grant award from Cal OES is hereby accepted in the amount of \$51,125 for the Sexual Assault Law Enforcement Specialized Units grant program, and the required twenty-five percent (25%) local match in the amount of \$17,042 is hereby authorized, for a total program cost increase of \$68,167.

2. The Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 Annual Budget is amended to increase the expenditure and revenue appropriation by \$68,167 for the Other Special Revenue Programs Cal OES Grant Program in the Police Grants & Special Programs Fund budget.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute all required contracts or agreements with the granting agency, attached as Exhibit 1, provide additional information, and furnish such documents as may be required; execute all documents and amendments or extensions pertaining to the grant project; and make all required appropriations in compliance with, and for the purposes stated in, the project contract.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to establish all required accounts and make any and all expenditures, appropriations, transfers, and/or distributions of funds on behalf of the City, as may be appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
