RESOLUTION APPROVING FINDINGS AND A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT THROUGH HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE TACTICAL RESPONSE VEHICLE AND ONE MOBILE COMMAND POST

The purchase of one Tactical Response Vehicle (TRV) and one Mobile Command Post (MCP) to be utilized by the Stockton Police Department (SPD) is recommended in response to the current Coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) as current resources are not adequate; and

The use of funds provided by the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) grant to purchase one TRV and one MCP is an eligible expense and appropriate use of the funds; and

Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) is a regional government cooperation and planning provider in the state of Texas which serves as a contracting agency to streamline the procurement process for public agencies and takes advantage of the most favorable pricing. The use of these contracts is optional and is available to local government agencies; and

H-GAC has a contract with LDV, Inc. for preferential pricing of one TRV and one MCP. The specifications for these units through the H-GAC contract meet the SPD requirements for this type of equipment; and

The LDV, Inc. Cooperative Purchasing Agreement was established pursuant to H-GAC's public competitive procurement process; and

For the purchase of one TRV and one MCP, staff recommends utilizing an H-GAC contract with LDV, Inc., in the amount of \$629,345; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby approves the following findings in support of granting an exception to the competitive bid process pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code (SMC) section 3.68.070:

a. H-GAC established a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with LDV, Inc. for the purchase of one TRV and one MCP.

b. The LDV, Inc. Cooperative Purchasing Agreement was established pursuant to H-GAC's public competitive procurement process on behalf of local governments.

c. Taking advantage of the leveraged procurement agreements negotiated by H-GAC will save the administrative expense of City staff conducting separate procurements.

d. The specifications for the TRV and MCP units available through the H-GAC contract meet the SPD requirements for this type of equipment.

2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement through H-GAC in the amount of \$629,345 for the purchase of one TRV and one MCP from LDV, Inc., a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
