RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000, FROM THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA ON BEHALF OF ITS DAVIS CAMPUS SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE KORET SHELTER MEDICINE PROGRAM, AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 ANNUAL BUDGET

The City of Stockton is eligible to receive \$200,000 in prepaid grant funds from The Regents of the University of California (UC) on behalf of its Davis Campus School of Veterinary Medicine Koret Shelter Medicine Program (KSMP); and

The City was notified of the approved grant award of \$200,000 from the UC Davis KSMP in October 2023; and

The Stockton Animal Shelter (SAS) will fund part-time staff, purchase an off-site adoption trailer, and increase cat Trap Neuter Release (TNR) surgery days; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby accepts the grant award in the amount of \$200,000 from the UC Davis KSMP.
- 2. The Fiscal Year 2023-24 Annual Budget is amended to appropriate \$200,000 in revenues and expenditures in the Police Department Special Grants Revenue Fund (280-282).
- 3. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
