RESOLUTION RE-ESTABLISHING THE AD-HOC COMMITTEE ON HOMELESSNESS AND APPOINTING COUNCILMEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE COMMITTEE

The Ad Hoc Committee on Homelessness was established by Council Resolution 2021-11-16-1208, re-established by Council Resolution 2023-08-22-1204 on August 22, 2023, and by Council Resolution 2024-06-18-1201 on June 18, 2024; and

Council Policy 3.06.010(4)(C) authorizes the City Council to establish or re-establish ad-hoc committees targeted towards specific issues; and

The Ad Hoc on Homelessness Committee expired on December 31, 2024, unless re-established or extended by resolution of the Council with appointments to be made by the Mayor based on the expertise and expressed interest of the Councilmembers; and

The City Council desires to re-establish the Ad-Hoc Committee on Homelessness to serve in an advisory capacity and review progress on the efforts toward addressing homelessness within the city; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. This City Council hereby approves the re-establishment of the Ad-Hoc Committee on Homelessness to serve in an advisory capacity, review progress on the efforts toward addressing homelessness with the city, and to expire on December 31, 2025.
