A RESOLUTION DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO MODIFY THE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT PLAN OF THE STOCKTON TOURISM BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

The City Council of the City of Stockton (City) renewed the Stockton Tourism Business Improvement District (STBID) and adopted the Management District Plan (MDP) of the STBID in 2014 under the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994, Streets and Highways Code section 36600 *et. seq.*, by Resolution No. 2014-11-04-1601-01; and

The Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994, Streets and Highways Code section 36600 *et. seq.*, allows cities to modify the MDP at the request of the owners' association; and

The STBID owners' association, the Stockton Convention & Visitors Bureau dba Visit Stockton (VS) has requested modification of the MDP; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council declares its intention to modify the STBID MDP.
- 2. The proposed modification of the STBID MDP will modify the end date of the STBID to December 31, 2024.
- 3. The time and place for a public hearing on modification of the STBID MDP are set for 5:30 PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on November 19, 2024, at the City Council Chambers located at City Hall, 425 N. El Dorado Street, 2nd Floor, Stockton, CA 95202.
 - 4. This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
