## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PHASE I ELEMENTS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR MEASURES A AND B, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2013-14 GENERAL FUND ANNUAL BUDGET TO INCLUDE MEASURE A REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES, AND AUTHORIZING 120 SWORN AND 43 CIVILIAN STAFF POSITIONS TO BE PHASED IN OVER FOUR FISCAL YEARS INCLUDING 40 ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICER POSITIONS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, 1 SENIOR HUMAN RESOURCES ANALYST IN HUMAN RESOURCES, 1 PROGRAM MANAGER II (CONF.), 1 SUPERVISING ACCOUNTANT, 1 SENIOR ACCOUNTANT, AND 1 FINANCE ASSISTANT IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO BEGIN RECRUITMENT IN FISCAL YEAR 2013-14

In 2009 the City of Stockton began implementing significant across-the-board budget cuts as a result of corresponding drops in realized revenue and local funding projections; and

In 2011 the City Council adopted the Marshall Plan on Crime, a Strategic Initiative to increase both real and perceived public safety; and

In 2012 the Police Department implemented a Violence Reduction Initiative, which introduced the focus of the Department on gang and gun violence to be achieved through the framework of the four P's: Pursuit, Predict, Prevent, and Partner; and

In 2013 the Police Department released a Three-Year Strategic Policing Plan, which included rebuilding the Department's staffing levels; and

On November 5, 2013, the citizens of Stockton approved Measure A, a ¾-cent sales tax measure effective April 1, 2014; and

The citizens of Stockton also approved Measure B, which earmarks 65% of the sales tax revenue towards increasing public safety through the continued implementation of the Marshall Plan; and

As described in the ballot language, the balance of Measure A funds will help end the bankruptcy and restore other City services including funding one-time mission critical needs; and

In addition to increasing Police Department staffing, five other positions are included to restore and maintain the City's financial health; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Measures A and B Implementation Plan Phase I as presented is hereby approved.
- 2. The Fiscal Year 2013-14 General Fund Annual Budget is hereby amended to include Measure A revenues and expenditures, as follows:

- 3. An additional 120 Sworn and 43 Civilian staff positions are hereby authorized to be phased in over four fiscal years including 40 Police Officer positions in the Police Department, 1 Senior Human Resources Analyst in Human Resources, 1 Program Manager II (Conf.), 1 Supervising Accountant, 1 Senior Accountant, and 1 Finance Assistant in Administrative Services Department to begin recruitment in Fiscal Year 2013-14.
- 4. The City Manager is authorized and directed to take whatever actions are necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this resolution.
