# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## **RESOLUTION ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE DELEGATED MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE SERVICE CONTRACT FOR THE HOMELESS EMPLOYMENT LITTER PROGRAM, PROJECT NO. OM-18-093**

On August 21, 2018, Council approved entering into a Delegated Maintenance Agreement with the State of California, acting by and through the California Department of Transportation, for litter abatement on freeway and State highway systems for reimbursement up to \$121,000 each fiscal year; and

Council also awarded a three-year Contract for Services in the amount of \$363,000, up to \$121,000 per fiscal year, to Ready to Work of Stockton, CA, for the Homeless Employment Litter Program, Project No. OM-18-093, which has already been extended one-year through August 31, 2022; and

On March 3, 2019, under administrative authority, the City Manager executed Amendment No. 1 to the Homeless Employment Litter Program Contract for Services with Ready to Work to allow increased working hours, days, and weeks to provide greater flexibility to schedule cleanups; and

On March 29, 2021, the City of Stockton received a request from the California Department of Transportation to increase the Delegated Maintenance Agreement value by an additional \$75,000 to accelerate the frequency of freeway shoulder cleanups through Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves accepting additional funding for the Delegated Maintenance Agreement with the California Department of Transportation, for which the City will be reimbursed an additional \$75,000 through FY 2021-22 for litter abatement on freeway and State highway systems.

2. The City Council approves the appropriation of additional funding in the amount of \$75,000 to both Public Works' operating revenue and operating expenditures accounts for FY 2021-22.

3. The City Council approves execution of Amendment No. 4 to the Service Contract with Ready to Work of Stockton, CA, for the Homeless Employment Litter Program, Project No. OM-18-093, to increase the annual FY 2021-22 amount by \$75,000,

for a total contract amount of \$738,000, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
