RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT TO STORM WATER INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES, LLC FOR UNDERGROUND STORMWATER TREATMENT DEVICES

The Municipal Utilities Department is required to regularly inspect and maintain its underground stormwater treatment devices to ensure proper function and compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit. To fulfill regulatory requirements and minimize the release of pollutants from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System, staff advertised a Request for Sealed Bids for the Inspection and Maintenance of Underground Stormwater Treatment Devices, Project No. PUR 25-005 on August 1, 2024; and

On September 12, 2024, the City received a total of two qualified bids. Storm Water Inspection and Maintenance Services, LLC (SWIMS) of Discovery Bay, CA, was the lowest responsive bidder; and

Staff recommend the award of a three-year contract to SWIMS for the inspection and maintenance of underground stormwater treatment devices for a total contract amount not-to-exceed \$479,985, and to authorize the City Manager to execute two (2) additional one (1) year options to extend the contract; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. A three-year contract for the inspection and maintenance of underground stormwater treatment devices with a total not-to-exceed amount of \$479,985 between the City of Stockton and Storm Water Inspection and Maintenance Services, LLC is hereby awarded, and the Interim City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. Authorize the City Manager to execute two (2) additional one (1) year contract extensions with Storm Water Inspection and Maintenance Services, LLC of Discovery Bay, CA.

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3. The Interim City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to take appropriate and necessary actions to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
