RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$1.8 MILLION FROM THE CALIFORNIANSFORALL YOUTH JOBS CORPS ROUND 3 GRANT PROGRAM

The City of Stockton ("City") is interested in promoting workforce development programs, particularly those that endeavor to empower youth; and

The State of California has made funding available for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Jobs Corps, which seeks to provide funding for local governments across the state to create programs that increase employment for underserved youth across California, develop meaningful public service career pathways, and enhance local government capacity to address challenges in key focus areas; and

The State of California seeks to amend the existing contract JP1013-GF-A1 with the City of Stockton to extend the performance period from December 31, 2025 to December 31, 2026, and additionally increase the grant award from \$1,773,664 to \$3,618,275, to continue the City's youth workforce program, and support local external workforce partners; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorize the City Manager to execute a grant agreement amendment with California Volunteers to increase the amount of the contract from \$1,773,664 to \$3,618,275 (an increase of \$1,844,611) and extend the timeline from December 31, 2025 to December 31, 2026, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference; and

2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant funds for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Jobs Corps in the amount of \$3,618,275; and
