## STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A ROUND 4 TRANSFORMATIVE CLIMATE COMMUNITIES IMPLEMENTATION GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,165,510

City Council approved Resolution 2022-06-21-1207 which authorized the City Manager to apply for a Round 4 TCC Implementation Grant in the amount of \$24,165,510; and

The City and its co-applicants ("Partners") developed and submitted an application for TCC Round 4 Implementation Grant funding entitled: *Stockton Rising*; and

On October 27, 2022, the California Strategic Growth Council, awarded the City a \$24,165,510 Round 4 Implementation Grant for *Stockton Rising*; and

The City and its Partners will use Round 4 grant funds to fulfill the original vision of the Round 3 application, and introduce new projects that are aligned with the priorities of the community-drive Sustainable Neighborhood Plan; and,

The projects that comprise *Stockton Rising* will achieve significant benefits through neighborhood-level transformation, such as a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions and improved local economic, environmental, and health outcomes in some of the most disadvantaged communities in *Stockton*; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize the City Manager to execute a grant agreement in the amount of \$24,165,510 with the California Strategic Growth Council.
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$24,165,510.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to execute and manage sub-agreements with co-applicants in amounts consistent with the Grant Agreement.
- 4. Authorize the allocation of four (4) grant-funded full time equivalent (FTE) positions within the City Manager's Office to oversee the administration of the grant.
