# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. CE017-17, REJECTING THE LOW BID FROM SAK CONSTRUCTION, LLC, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, LLC FOR THE BLACK OAK PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION (PROJECT NO. M15002)**

On April 6, 2017, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the Black Oak Public Utility Easement (PUE) Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Project No. M15002); and

The project will rehabilitate 40-linear feet of 18-inch, 3,257-linear feet of 30-inch, and 450-linear feet of 48-inch sewer trunk line along Black Oak PUE between Pershing Avenue and Alexandria Place; and

SAK Construction, LLC, the apparent low bidder, submitted a bid that was non-responsive; and

The bid from Insituform Technologies, LLC, the second lowest bidder, has been determined to be responsive; and

The project is, therefore, awarded to Insituform Technologies, LLC, the second lowest bidder, in the amount of \$1,702,029, because its bid is regular and responsive in all respects; and

This project is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to approve the filing of Notice of Exemption No. CE017-17 under CEQA for the Black Oak PUE Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Project No. M15002), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the Black Oak PUE Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Project No. M15002).

3. The City Council rejects the low bid as non-responsive from SAK Construction, LLC, for the Black Oak PUE Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Project No. M15002).

4. A Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Insituform Technologies, LLC, in the amount of \$1,702,029, is hereby awarded, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
