# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE06-20, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDING, TRANSFERRING FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE HIGH FRICTION SURFACE TREATMENT, PROJECT NO. WT16022/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. HSIPL-5008(153)**

On January 7, 2021, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the High Friction Surface Treatment, Project No. WT16022 (formerly PW1622)/Federal Project No. HSIPL- 5008(153); and

The project will apply a surface treatment to increase pavement friction and install radar feedback signs warning drivers about their speed at locations along Feather River Drive, Brookside Road, Bianchi Road, and Manthey Road; and

Dirt Dynasty, Inc. is the second lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$842,847.50, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

Caltrans National Environmental Policy Act determination was received on September 14, 2018. The State determined that the project is a Categorical Exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(3). Similarly, the project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code section 65402; and

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City's jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE06-20 under CEQA for the High Friction Surface Treatment, Project No. WT16022 (formerly PW1622)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(153), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the High Friction Surface Treatment, Project No. WT16022 (formerly PW1622)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(153).

3. The City Council approves the appropriation of additional grant funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 from the Highway Safety Improvement Program to the High Friction Surface Treatment, Project No. WT16022 (formerly PW1622)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(153).

4. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$216,000.00 from the Wilson Way Bridge Slope Protection Installation, Project No. WT18021 (formerly PW1821) to the High Friction Surface Treatment, Project No. WT16022 (formerly PW1622)/Federal Project No. HSIPL-5008(153).

5. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and Dirt Dynasty, Inc., in the amount of \$842,847.50, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
