2nd Quarter FY 2023-24 General Fund Revenues

As of December 31, 2023:

- Year to Date = \$76.6 million
 - 25.1% of the \$305.3 million budget

Year-end Projection:

- \$320.3 million
 - \$14.9 million, 4.9% over the budget
 - Largest variances:
 - Business License Tax +\$4.5 million
 - Property Taxes +\$3.6 million
 - Rev. from Other Agencies +\$2.7 million



Revenues

Proceeding as expected – tax revenues can take up to 90 days to post.

Operating revenues are showing signs of mild cooling anticipated by City's consultants.





2nd Quarter FY 2023-24 General Fund Expenditures

As of December 31, 2023:

- Expenditures = \$129.0 million
 - 38% of the \$340.0 million budget

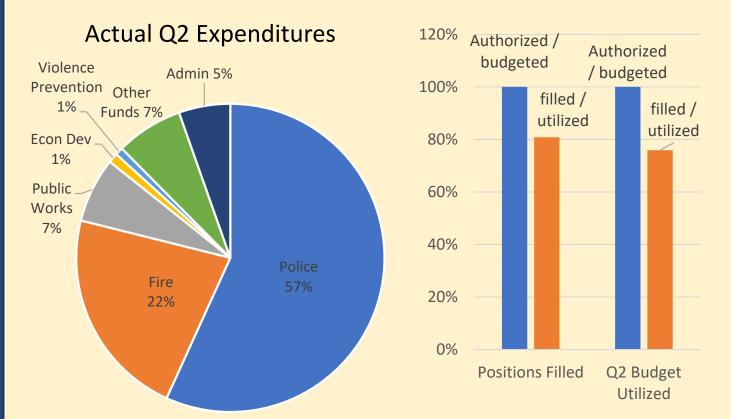
Year-end Projection:

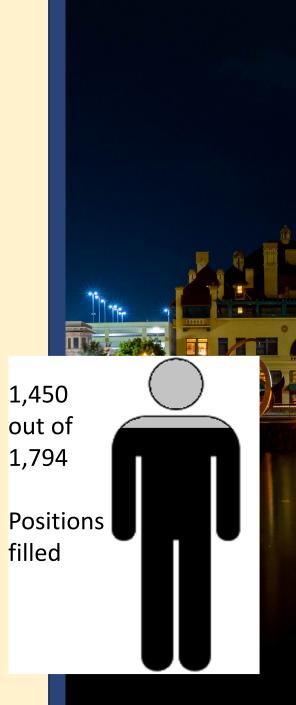
- \$310.4 million
 - \$29.6 million, 8.7% under budget
 - Police Department \$17.6 million
 - Economic Development \$4.4 million
 - Public Works \$3.7 million



Expenditures

- Expenditures also proceeding as expected.
- Currently at 38% Budget Utilization
 - Due to Salary Savings & Multi-year expenditures that have not posted yet.





2nd Quarter FY 2023-24 Recommendations

- Accept 2nd Quarter Budget Status Update report.
- Adopt Resolution approving three budget amendments:
- Appropriate \$363,979 from the Development Services fund balance to cover the IT ISFs expense
- 2. Appropriate \$110,508 from the Development fund balance and \$208,727 from the Measure K fund balance to cover Indirect Costs
- Transfer funds in the amount of \$145,000 from the Traffic Signal Modification, Project No. WT15029 to the Lighted Crosswalk Upgrades, Project No. WT15026
