# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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## RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 3, 1992

WHEREAS, a consolidated General Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election was held on November 3, 1992, pursuant to Stockton City Charter Article XXIV; and

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters ("Registrar") was authorized to canvass the returns of the election pursuant to an agreement between the City of Stockton and the County of San Joaquin entered into on January 22, 1990, and amended September 11, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar has conducted the canvass and stated the results (dated December 1, 1992) in the "Certificate of Results of the City of Stockton General Municipal Election held on November 3, 1992," and in the "Certificate of Results of the City of Stockton Charter Amendment Election Held on November 3, 1992" (collectively, "Certificate of Results"); and

WHEREAS, California Elections Code sections 22932 and 22933 require the adoption of a resolution reciting the facts of the election and a statement of the results; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the whole number of votes cast in the City of Stockton was 64,169, as confirmed by the Registrar.

2. The names of the persons voted for, the offices for which they were voted and the total number of votes given in each precinct and the City to each person; the measure(s) voted upon and the total number of votes for and against said measure(s) in each precinct and the City are as set forth in the "Certificate of Results" prepared by the Registrar, dated December 1, 1992, attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.

3. That the number of votes given at each precinct to each person and for and against the measure(s) is as set forth in Exhibit "A."

4. That JOAN DARRAH received the greatest number of votes for the office of Mayor at-large and is hereby declared elected for a term commencing January 1, 1993 and terminating December 31, 1996.

5. That MEL PANIZZA received the greatest number of votes for the office of Councilmember from District 2 and is hereby declared elected for a term commencing January 1, 1993 and terminating December 31, 1996.

6. That TED A. GONZALES received the greatest number of votes for the office of Councilmember from District 4 and is hereby declared elected for a term commencing January 1, 1993 and terminating December 31, 1996.

7. That FLOYD H. WEAVER received the greatest number of votes for the office of Councilmember from District 6 and is hereby declared elected for a term commencing January 1, 1993 and terminating December 31, 1996.

8. That a majority of votes was cast in favor of each of the following measures and they are hereby declared approved:

(1) MEASURE R: Shall the Charter of the City of Stockton be revised and amended to provide for the City Council to determine the time and place for holding regular and special meetings; for the public to have access to minutes and records for sessions open to the public in accordance with state law; and for Council to designate the terms and conditions of employment of its appointees?

(2) MEASURE S: Shall the Charter of the City of Stockton be revised and amended to provide for the City Council to act by ordinance, resolution or motion; for specific actions of the Council to be done by ordinance; for the Council to hold a public hearing before taking final action establishing a tax, assessment, or fee schedule; for publication of an ordinance by title only; for

requiring one reading of an ordinance or resolution; and for establishing procedures for the lease of public property?

(3) MEASURE T: Shall the Charter be amended to delete Article XIV, entitled Department of Health, which establishes a city physician and delegates public health functions to other agencies?


(4) MEASURE U: Shall the City Charter be amended to require that City voters must approve any arbitration decisions regarding Fire Department employee wages, benefits, or other working conditions before such decisions can be effective; that any additional revenues and appropriations necessary to fund such arbitration decisions must also be approved by City voters; and, that elections for such approvals need not be held more than once in any calendar year?

(5) MEASURE V: Shall the City Charter be amended to require submission of proposed contract terms to binding arbitration in the event the City and any Fire Department employee organization cannot agree on a negotiated contract of terms and conditions of employment and to add to the Charter a provision to prohibit strikes by firefighters?




