STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL DISPLAY OF THE MILITARY FLAGS IN COMMEMORATION OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF EACH BRANCH

City Council Policy 2.07 regulates the display of National, State, and other flags and clearly states that the City of Stockton flagpoles located at City-owned buildings and facilities are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression of the public; and

The City Council may, by resolution, direct staff to display commemorative flags as an expression of the City's official sentiments; and

The City Council desires to display the flags of the United States Military Branches annually to commemorate their respective dates of establishment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to have the flags of the United State Military branches displayed to commemorate their respective dates of establishment annually on the following dates.

<u>United States Army</u>: June 14 United States Navy: October 13

United States Marine Corps: November 10

<u>United States Coast Guard</u>: August <u>United States Air Force</u>: September 18 <u>United States Space Force</u>: December 20
