RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR LOCAL ASSISTANCE SPECIFIED GRANT SECTION 206, ITEM NO. (13)(E) FOR \$4,000,000 TO THE CITY OF STOCKTON FOR AQUATIC AND PARK FACILITIES FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION STATEWIDE PARK PROGRAM

The State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of a Local Assistance Specified Grant Section 206, Item No. (13)(E) in the amount of \$4,000,000 to the City of Stockton for Aquatic and Park Facilities, setting up necessary procedures governing application(s); and

Said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of project application(s) before submission of said application(s) to the State; and

The applicant will enter into a contract(s) with the State of California to complete project(s); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Approves the filing of project application(s) for Local Assistance Specified Section 206, Item No. (13)(E) in the amount of \$4,000,000 for City of Stockton Aquatic and Park Facilities.
2. Certifies that said applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of project work utilizing Local Assistance Specified funding, sufficient funds to complete the project.
3. Certifies that the applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project(s).
4. Certifies that the applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the General Provisions contained in the contract shown in the Procedural Guide.
5. Delegates the authority to the City Manager, or designee, to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the grant scope.

6. Agrees to comply with all applicable federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, and guidelines.

7. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
