RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL DISPLAY OF THE JUNETEENTH FLAG INCOMMEMORATION OF THE EMMANCIPATION OF ENSLAVED AFRICAN AMERICANS ON JUNE 19, 1865

City Council Policy 2.07 regulates the display of National, State, and other flags and clearly states that the City of Stockton flagpoles located at City-owned buildings and facilities are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression of the public; and

The City Council may, by resolution, direct staff to display commemorative flags as an expression of the City's official sentiments; and

The City Council desires to display the Juneteenth flag to commemorate the Emancipation of Enslaved African Americans on June 19, 1865; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to have the Juneteenth flag displayed annually on June 19th.
