# STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

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**RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS AND AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE AIRPORT WAY AND SIXTH STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND SYNCHRONIZATION, PROJECT NO. WT25040/FEDERAL PROJECT NO. CRPL-5008(217)**

On November 5, 2025, the City advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) for design of the Airport Way and Sixth Street Traffic Signal Installation and Synchronization, Project No WT25040/Federal Project No. CRPL-5008(217). Three proposals were received; and

The project will install a traffic signal at Airport Way and Sixth Street and synchronize the signals along Airport Way between Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Arch Airport Road; and

Siegfried Engineering, Inc. was determined to be the most qualified and highest ranked firm for this project. Staff negotiated a fee in the amount of \$215,000 with Siegfried Engineering, Inc. for design services; and

Transfer of funds is needed for the City's required local match of \$28,503; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$28,503 from the Grant Match, Project No. WT21016, to the Airport Way and Sixth Street Traffic Signal Installation and Synchronization, Project No. WT25040/Federal Project No. CRPL-5008(217).

2. The City Council approves findings pursuant to Stockton Municipal Code (SMC) section 3.68.070 in support of an exception to the competitive bidding process. These findings include:

- a. The City does not have sufficient staff resources to design this project.
- b. The scope of design services requires an engineering firm experienced in the design of traffic signal and traffic signal synchronization.
- c. Use of the RFP process is appropriate for this Professional Services Contract because it relies on the evaluation of professional qualifications

and performance as the basis for selection of a vendor. Use of the criteria helps ensure selection of a vendor that will provide the highest quality professional service, which is in the public interest.

- d. The City negotiated a contract following solicitation of competitive proposals in accordance with SMC section 3.68.070.A.3.

3. The City Council awards a Professional Services Contract between the City of Stockton and Siegfried Engineering, Inc., in the amount of \$215,000, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
