- 1. The City Council hereby approves the selection of Brodsky, Micklow, Bull & Weiss, LLP to advise the City in maritime matters and other proceedings as the need arises.
- 2. The City Attorney is authorized to execute an agreement for legal services with the law firm of Brodsky, Micklow, Bull & Weiss, LLP, in substantially the form as attached as Exhibit "1" and incorporated by this reference.
