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Chapter 2.64 EMPLOYMENT OF STOCKTON/SAN JOAQUIN SPORTS COMMISSION EMPLOYEES

2.64.010 Adoption.

The ordinance codified in this chapter is adopted pursuant to Article X, Section 1002 of the Charter of the City to prescribe the qualifications and conditions applicable to the employment by the City of an employee of the Stockton/San Joaquin Sports Commission, the functions of which the City is assuming by agreement. (Prior code § 2-1301)

2.64.020 Classification.

The City Manager may employ a Stockton/San Joaquin Sports Commission employee in any position which is excluded from the competitive service by operation of Section 2.36.060 of this code. (Prior code § 2-1302)

2.64.030 Physical examination.

Employee shall be examined by the City Physician in accordance with City standards applied to all original hire employees. (Prior code § 2-1303)

2.64.040 Educational requirements.

Any employee shall comply with the educational requirements contained in the applicable class specification at the time of employment. (Prior code § 2-1304)

2.64.050 Salaries.

The City Manager shall designate the appropriate step in the City salary schedule for each person employed pursuant to this chapter. (Prior code § 2-1305)

2.64.060 Ratification.

The employment by the City Manager of any person in accordance with the provisions of this chapter but prior to the effective date of the ordinance adopting this chapter is hereby ratified. (Prior code § 2-1306)

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
