RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT 2020 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT

The Stockton Fire Department (“SFD”) applied for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) seeking funds to assist the City in hiring nine (9) Firefighters; and

On September 10, 2021, SFD was notified by FEMA that the City of Stockton was awarded \$4,810,101.03 for the 2020 SAFER Grant to hire nine (9) Firefighter positions for three (3) years; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept grant funds from FEMA for the 2020 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant in the amount of \$4,810,101.03, to hire nine (9) Firefighters for three (3) years.
2. The City Manager is directed to make all necessary budget appropriations for the purposes stated in the grant agreement.
3. Total authorized full-time positions are increased by nine grant-funded firefighter positions.
4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
