## RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$1.5 MILLION FROM THE CALIFORNIANSFORALL YOUTH SERVICE CORPS PROGRAM

The City of Stockton (“City”) is interested in promoting workforce development programs, particularly those that endeavor to empower youth; and

The City of Stockton recognizes that early workforce development opportunities can provide youth with valuable professional experience, career exposure, mentorship, and pathways to long-term economic mobility; and

The City of Stockton has successfully administered prior rounds of CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps funding through the Stockton Youth Employment Summer Success (YESS) Program, which has provided paid employment opportunities and professional development services to hundreds of local youth; and

The State of California has made funding available for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps Program, which seeks to create paid workforce development opportunities for underserved youth across California while developing workforce pathways and enhancing public service career awareness; and

The State of California has awarded the City of Stockton funding in the amount of \$1,500,471 to support implementation of the Stockton Youth Employment Summer Success (Y.E.S.S.) Program and related workforce development activities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Authorize the City Manager to execute a grant agreement with California Volunteers for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps Program in the amount of \$1,500,471 for the term of January 1, 2027, through December 31, 2027, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.

2. Authorize the City Manager to appropriate grant funds for the CaliforniansForAll Youth Service Corps Program in the amount of \$1,500,471.
