STOCKTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) AND APPROPRIATE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$275,918.49 FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING OFFICER WELLNESS AND EXPANDING MENTAL HEALTH SOURCES

Pursuant to Assembly Bill 178, Chapter 45, Statutes of 2022, Item 5227-121-0001, amounts specified are appropriated from the General Fund; and

Assembly Bill 178, Chapter 45, Statutes of 2022 included a provision of \$275,918.49 for the City of Stockton to improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby accepts a local law enforcement Budget Act of 2022 disbursement of \$275,918.49 from the BSCC.
2. The City Council hereby appropriates revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$275,918.49 in the Police Department's Fiscal Year 2022-23 Special Revenue Fund (280-282).
3. The City Manager is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
