## **RESOLUTION APPOINTING TEN MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE CLIMATE ACTION PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE SIERRA CLUB AND THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF CALIFORNIA**

On September 8, 2008, the City Council approved a Memorandum of Agreement with the Attorney General of California and the Sierra Club regarding the General Plan litigation. A component of the Memorandum of Agreement was the establishment and maintenance of an Advisory Committee consisting of representatives from environmental, non-profit, labor, business, and developer interests; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council shall appoint members of the community to serve on the Climate Action Plan Advisory Committee.

2. The following members are appointed to the Climate Action Plan Advisory Committee for a term of two years beginning on immediately upon City Council ratification and ending September 30, 2019:

### **Non-Profit**

Jasmine Leek – Third City Coalition

### **Business**

Julia Cox – Berkshire Hathaway Drysdale Properties  
Jeremy Terhune – Defenders of Wildlife (Incumbent)

### **Developer**

John Beckman – Building Industry Association (Incumbent)  
David Nelson – A.G. Spanos Co. (Incumbent)

### **Labor**

Chris Pedroza – Northern California Carpenters Regional Council (Incumbent)  
Chris Greaney – Heat and Frost Insulators Local 16

### **Environmental**

Randall Hatch – Randy Hatch Planning Consultation (Incumbent)  
Manuel Garcia – Sustainability Consultant for San Joaquin Delta College

3. Said appointments will be for a term of two years. Members may serve for one term and continue for unlimited terms subject to reappointment by the City Council.

4. The City Manager is authorized to take such other actions as are necessary and appropriate to carry out the intent of this resolution.
