To Whom it May Concern at the City of Stockton, California ("City"),

I, Wilbur Meyers, am the property owner of 1504 Faye St., located in Stockton, California, being APN: 163-250-18. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with my consent to the vacation of Temple St. (the "Road"), which is adjacent to my property, as described herein. I am aware that the City plans to vacate the Road. I am in communication with the other adjacent property owner, USA Waste of California, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("UWC"), successor by merger from Stockton Scavengers Association, a California corporation. UWC and I discussed the north end of the Road being divided down the center between UWC and me, as it is standard practice to do so. I am in agreement with and consent to this vacation as more particularly shown on the enclosed map.

I was also informed that as part of the new Cul-de-Sac at the end of Faye St., there will be a catch basin/storm drain, which connects to the City's storm water, inside the area that will be vacated to me ("Meyers Vacated Area"). Since this storm drain, located in the Meyers Vacated Area, will no longer be inside the City's right-of-way, I acknowledge and agree that I will be responsible, at my sole cost and expense, for all clean-up and maintenance to said storm drain, and such clean-up and maintenance shall not be the responsibility of the City or of UWC.
