RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ACTIONS IN SUPPORT OF ENHANCED SECURITY MEASURES AT CITY HALL, INCLUDING THE CREATION OF A NEW UNCLASSIFIED/UNREPRESENTED CLASS SPECIFICATION OF SECURITY SERVICES MANAGER IN THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE, APPROVAL OF ITS PROPOSED SALARY RANGE, AND AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH A PROJECT BUDGET WITHIN PUBLIC WORKS TO SUPPORT ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS

In January 2025, the Stockton Police (SPD) and Public Works (PW) Departments began a security assessment and site review of the City's current City Hall, at 425 North El Dorado Street. Upon completion of the review, several recommendations for improvement were presented to the Mayor and Council; and

It is necessary to establish a new classification of Security Services Manager to provide oversight of citywide security services, reporting to the City Manager's Office. This new position does not have an associated budget throughout the remainder of Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25, therefore a budget appropriation to fund the Security Services Manager through the remainder of FY 2024-25 is needed; and

The SPD and PW also prepared a list of recommended equipment and infrastructure improvements for City Hall and the existing Council Chambers. A budget appropriation and purchasing authority is necessary to implement the recommended improvements. Some of the equipment included in this plan can be moved to the new City Hall, as the construction of Council Chambers nears completion; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The new unclassified/unrepresented class specification of Security Services Manager is hereby created with the salary approved as follows:

- a. The Director of Human Resources is hereby directed to prepare and finalize the appropriate class specification in accordance with Section 2.36.080 of the Stockton Municipal Code.

2. Authorize the addition of one new full-time employee (FTE) to the City Manager's Office, and associated budget appropriation to support the Security Services Manager from April through June 2025.

3. Authorize the establishment of a Public Works project budget of \$186,755 for Enhanced Security Measures at City Hall and authorize corresponding purchases needed to procure equipment and services to implement the enhanced security plan.

4. Authorize a budget appropriation of \$236,479 from the General Fund Reserves, as follow:

- \$49,724 to the City Manager's Office Regular Salaries and associated benefits accounts, intended to cover April through June 2025 salaries.
- \$186,755 to the Public Works Department to establish the Enhanced Security Measures at City Hall project budget.

5. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
