RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION NO. NOE09-20, APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, TRANSFERRING FUNDING, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2016 SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION, PROJECT NO. UW16006

On January 12, 2023, the City Clerk of the City of Stockton opened, examined, and publicly declared the sealed proposals or bids offered for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. UW16006; and

The Municipal Utilities Department has implemented a Condition Assessment Program for the City's sewer infrastructure. This program generates a prioritized list of replacement and/or rehabilitation projects for inclusion in the City's Capital Improvement Plan; and

The program identified approximately 2,850 linear feet of existing sewer lines on Elmwood Avenue, Harding Way, El Monte Street, and Julian Street; and

California Trenchless, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,297,130, and its bid is regular in all respects; and

The project is in conformance with the City's General Plan, pursuant to California Government Code, section 65402, and is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as specified under section 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines, because this is a discretionary project under the City jurisdiction and qualifies as a project which has been determined to not have a significant effect on the environment; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council approves the filing of Notice of Exemption No. NOE09-20 under CEQA for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. UW16006, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 1 and incorporated by this reference.
2. The City Council approves the plans and specifications for the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. UW16006.
3. The City Council approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$488,000 from the Wastewater Utility Fund Balance to the 2016 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Project No. UW16006 (formerly M16006).

4. The City Council awards a Construction Contract between the City of Stockton and California Trenchless, Inc., in the amount of \$1,297,130, and the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute same, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 2 and incorporated by this reference.

5. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
