RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDING AS A SUB-RECIPIENT FOR THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORATION SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT AWARDED TO SAN JOAQUIN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

The City of Stockton is eligible to serve as a sub-recipient for funding under the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program (Program); and

The City of Stockton coordinated with the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) on the submittal of a grant application to the Program for funding under the Strategic Partnerships category; and

SJCOG received a grant award of \$450,000 for the Downtown Stockton Multimodal Transportation Network and Land Use Compatibility Action Plan; and

The award requires a Local Match of \$18,500; and

The City of Stockton staff will conduct planning activities to enhance the Downtown multimodal network and propose infrastructure recommendations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept the grant suballocation from SJCOG as a subrecipient, contribute the local match requirement, execute and submit all documents including agreements, amendments, and payment requests, and make all necessary appropriations in compliance with and for the purposes stated in the grant award and application.

2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take whatever actions are necessary and appropriate to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
