**RESOLUTION REINSTATING JOSEPH DOLLAR TO THE POSITION OF
COLLECTION SYSTEMS OPERATOR, REGULAR STATUS,
EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 16, 2015**

WHEREAS, Joseph Dollar was appointed to the position of Collections Systems Operator in the Municipal Utilities Department on April 18, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2015, Joseph Dollar resigned from the position of Water/Sewer Equipment Operator in the Municipal Utilities Department in good standing as evidenced by the record on file; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2015, Joseph Dollar submitted a written request for reinstatement to the position of Collections Systems Operator in the Municipal Utilities Department; and the Municipal Utilities Director has consented to such reinstatement; and

WHEREAS, there is an available vacant position of the same class, which the City Manager has approved for filling; and

WHEREAS, Rule VII, section 7(a) of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations for Miscellaneous employees provides for reinstatement of an employee who has resigned in good standing; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Joseph Dollar is hereby certified for reinstatement to the position of Collections Systems Operator, regular status, in the Municipal Utilities Department effective December 16, 2015.

2. That Joseph Dollar shall be reinstated at step 5 of the Collection Systems Operator salary as stated in the current salary schedule and with the same service time as attained at the time of resignation.
